**Birthday/Pool Party Information**  
**COST & PAYMENT:**

Two (2) hours minimum lifeguard and facility rental  
\$125 non-refundable deposit required to hold date and time

Payment of the balance may be made by cash or check and is due before the party begins.  
For your party's safety and enjoyment, we require a 30:1 ratio! (Max. 55:2 ratio)

**Lifeguards are needed for both pool and deck time.**  
MAXIMUM Capacity (pool and deck) are as followed:

RATES: \$105.00 per hour (30 people) \$125.00 per hour (55 people) \$15.00 for use of BBQ Grill (additional charge)

**PARTY PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Pool party hosts may come no more than fifteen (15) minutes before starting time to set up. No confetti is allowed in the pool area.
2. A gas barbeque is on the premises for your convenience, though there is a \$15.00 charge if used. Please bring your own cooking utensils and any extras you may need.
3. **Please inform your guests that there is NO PARKING in the retail parking lot next door.**
4. No one may enter the water before the Lifeguards have given permission. Swimming starts at a designated time and NOT earlier.
5. All swimmers MUST wear swim wear attire to enter pool.
6. Deck activities, games and/or toys must be **PRE-APPROVED** and finalized by a Lucky Duck manager 5 days in advance of the party.
7. **Parents** are to supervise their child/children at all times.
8. Swim Diapers (we do sell them if necessary) are **REQUIRED** for all children 3 years old and younger, and for everyone not potty trained. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
9. **Children ages 3 and under must be accompanied by an adult in the water.**
10. 15 minutes before pool reservation time is over, all swimmers will be asked to exit pool. Shortly after that time, the pool will be covered.
11. We reserve the right to refuse the pool to anyone who doesn't conduct themselves in a safe manner or not conform to the pool safety rules we have set here and on the reverse side of this agreement.
12. All pool party attendees must leave the premises within fifteen (15) minutes after the pool party ending time.
13. The host will be held accountable for leaving the premises clean.
14. Any property damage will be the responsibility of the host.

**Our pool rules have been set up for your safety and for the well being of you and your guests. Please see that your guests are made aware of these safety rules, as you are ultimately responsible for the actions and the conduct of those you have chosen to attend your party on our premises.**

**BIRTHDAY PARTY SAFETY RULES**

- To avoid injuries, absolutely **NO GLASS/ CERAMIC** containers or bottles allowed on the premises.
  - Each swimmer will be tested by a Lifeguard in the shallow end of the water before being allowed in the deeper water.
  - The Buoy line is for safety purposes. Please do not hold down or sit down on the line.
  - Only one person on the diving board at any one time. No repetitious Jumping / bouncing on diving board.
  - Wait for diving area to clear before diving off the diving board.
  - No eating in pool
  - No running anywhere.
  - No rough play in or out of the water.
  - **No diving or jumping in the shallow water, please walk down steps to enter in pool.**
  - No alcohol or recreational drugs allowed.
  - **SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED ANYWHERE ON THE PREMESIS.**
- ✓ Long hair is to be tied back
  - ✓ All jewelry should be removed
  - ✓ Sunscreen should be applied ½ hour before entering pool
  - ✓ To avoid injury, please clip fingernails
  - ✓ Give food time to digest before reentering pool

Lifeguard(s) is/are in charge at all times. Adults in attendance are expected to assist and cooperate with the lifeguard(s).  
Repeated warnings from the lifeguard will be grounds for ejection from the pool party.

\*Any guests with special health requirements should be brought to the attention of the lifeguard(s) upon arrival.
